**Confirmation of Return for August 2018**

We enclose a form for your son/daughter. We would be grateful if you would fill it in and return to the school on **Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> May** where it will be collected during Tutorial. **Please do not send in the form before May 16<sup>th</sup>.** It is extremely important that this form is returned on this day to secure your son/daughters place for next year as there are waiting lists for each year group and we need to be able to notify prospective applicants of available places.

The Proposed School fees for August 2018 (Fees will be finalised once ratified by the LMETB Board) are now online and available to purchase on Wisepay. The first instalment of fees for the school year 2018/19 for each student must be paid online **by Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2018**. An explanation of fees and an instalment payment plan for each year group is included. We ask that all outstanding accounts be cleared before confirmation of return for 2018/19 can commence. **Wisepay is our preferred method of payment.**

For parents/guardians who do not have access to the internet at home then internet access for the purpose of **Wisepay payments only** will be made available in the school every morning between 09.30am and 11.00am.

If you are unable to make payment via wisepay then payment will be accepted by Cheque or Postal order only. **For security reasons we cannot accept cash.** Parents can make a cheque/postal order payment directly to the office every morning between 09.30am and 11.00am.

**To make payment via Wisepay:**

Every parent/guardian has been provided with a username and password for their secure *Wisepay* account. If you are having difficulties accessing Wisepay or have misplaced your username/password please contact Vicky in the main office on 01-8254102 between 9.00am and 3.30pm daily or via email [vtugwell.rth@lmetb.ie](mailto:vtugwell.rth@lmetb.ie).

## **Breakdown of payments:**

### **2<sup>nd</sup> Year Students**

The cost of your fees this year will be **€140** and will include: Locker Rental, Dialann, Photocopying, 24 hour insurance, schoology, SPHE talks, Sports day fee, Geography field trip, CSPE field trip and maths ebook

### **3<sup>rd</sup> Year Students**

The cost of your fees this year will be **€200** and will include: Locker Rental, Dialann, Photocopying, 24 hour insurance, schoology, SPHE talks, English theatre Trip, Sports day fee, past examination papers, Mock examination papers, Aptitude Testing and Study Skills day.

### **4<sup>th</sup> Year Students**

The fee for transition year is **€450**. Thank you to all parents who have started on the payment plan for this. At this point you should have your deposit plus the first instalments paid (€250.).

### **5<sup>th</sup> Year and 6<sup>th</sup> Year Students (Established Leaving Certificate)**

The cost of your fees this year will be **€200** (5<sup>th</sup> Year's only) and **€275** (6<sup>th</sup> Year's only) and will include: Book Rental, Locker Rental, Dialann, Photocopying, 24 hour insurance, SPHE talks, Sports Day fee, past examination papers (5<sup>th</sup> Years only), Mock examination papers (6<sup>th</sup> Years only), Aptitude testing (5<sup>th</sup> years only), Mock examination Corrections (6<sup>th</sup> Year only), Higher options conference (6<sup>th</sup> Year only), English theatre trip (6<sup>th</sup> Year only) and Study Skills day (6<sup>th</sup> Year only).

**Note:** *Included in the senior fee is a book rental deposit of €70. It will be re-paid in full on return of **all** the 6<sup>th</sup> year books when they leave the school. If books are not returned (or are returned in very poor condition) the full deposit may not be returned.*

**Note:** *Junior and Leaving Certificate exam fees (**3<sup>rd</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> Year only**) are now due. These are €109 and €116 respectively and are paid online directly to the State Examinations Commission. Holders of a full Medical card do not have to pay this fee.*

### **5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Year Leaving Certificate Applied Students**

The cost of your fees this year will be **€90** (5<sup>th</sup> Year's only) and **€100** (6<sup>th</sup> Year's only) and will include: Schoology, Locker Rental, Dialann, 24 hour insurance, Mock examination papers (6<sup>th</sup> Years only), Mock examination Corrections (6<sup>th</sup> Year only), Higher options conference (6<sup>th</sup> Year only) and a Study skills day (6<sup>th</sup> Year only).

**NB** Please note iPads and Screen Breakage are **not** covered by these fees and any cost incurred in repairing iPads/Screens will be the responsibility of the student

### **Examinations and Reporting Information:**

Students are currently doing their end of year assessments. Reports for **1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> years** will be completed on-line on our **e portal system** by Tuesday **May 22<sup>nd</sup>**. Hard copies of reports are available only on request.

The 5<sup>th</sup> years will have their English exams on June 2<sup>nd</sup>. Their completed reports will be available from Tuesday June 6<sup>th</sup>. It is imperative that all **5<sup>th</sup> year students maintain full attendance right up to the last day of term**. Please refrain from booking holidays or making medical appointments during this timeframe. Subject teachers will be commencing the **6<sup>th</sup> year elements of course work** between Tuesday May 8<sup>th</sup> and Thursday May 31<sup>st</sup>.

### **Other Information**

#### **6<sup>th</sup> Year Parents: Invite to Service:**

There will be a short service to mark the end of the student's time in Ratoath College and to pray for their success in the Leaving Certificate. This will be held in the Holy Trinity Church, Ratoath on **Monday 21<sup>st</sup> May at 14.00.** We welcome parents/grandparents/guardians to the service.

#### **3<sup>rd</sup> Year Parents: Invite to Service:**

Our 3<sup>rd</sup> years will finish on **Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> May.** That afternoon at 14.00 we will have a short service with them and pray for their success in the Junior Certificate. We would love if their parents/Grandparents/Guardians would be free to join us on the day.

#### **Transition Year – Invite to Graduation:**

All 4<sup>th</sup> Years and their parents are invited to a graduation service on Thursday May 24<sup>th</sup> at 19.30. The service will include a presentation by students of all their achievements this year.
